" For the eggs alone, we'll gladly go for a walk in Karpacz, even though the game itself sounds like a fun challenge for our girls!"



# Terra Easter Egg Painting Instructions

- 1. cleaning the surface
- Thoroughly wipe the surface of the egg to remove dust.
- 2. choice of paint
- Use an acrylic paint for outdoor use, preferably one that is resistant to UV radiation, humidity and temperature changes.
- 3. choice of painting tools
- Choose a brush, roller or sprayer depending on the size of the egg and the preferred effect.
- 4. paint application
- Apply the paint evenly, preferably in thin layers.
- 5. wait according to the manufacturer's recommendations until it has dried (usually several hours).
- 6 Painting conditions
- Paint in a well-ventilated place for better drying.
- Optimal temperature: 10 °C 30 °C.
- Avoid painting in the rain or high humidity.
- 7 Surface treatment
- When the paint is completely dry, apply a clear varnish (preferably varnish).
- Apply two coats, with an appropriate drying time in between.
- 8 Final curing
- Allow the egg to cure completely as recommended by the varnish manufacturer.
